- for the removal of corns

***Directions***

- wash affected area and dry area thoroughly
- if necessary, cut medicated patch to fit corn
- apply adhesive side down of medicated patch onto corn
- cover medicated patch with pad
- after 48 hours, remove medicated patch
- repeat procedure every 48 hours as needed for up to 14 days (until corn is removed)
- may soak corn in warm water for 5 minutes to assist in removal

***Other information***

store between 15°C to 30°C (59°F to 86°F)

***Inactive ingredients***

acrylic adhesive, acrylic polymer, polyethylene, polyvinyl alcohol

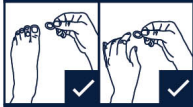
