Ask a doctor before use if the child has

- a breathing problem such as chronic bronchitis • glaucoma

Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if the child is taking sedatives or tranquilizers

When using this product

- marked drowsiness may occur • sedatives and tranquilizers may increase drowsiness
- excitability may occur, especially in children

Keep out of the reach of children. In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away (1-800-222-1222).

Directions

- find the right dose on chart below
- mL=milliliter • take every 4 to 6 hours, or as directed by a doctor • do not take more than 6 doses in 24 hours • use only enclosed dosing cup specifically designed for use with this product. Do not use any other dosing device.
