A palatable oral suspension for use as an aid in controlling simple diarrhea in cattle, horses, dogs and cats.

**DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION:**

Administer orally.

**Dogs and Cats:** 1 to 3 tablespoonfuls every 1-3 hours.

**Calves and Foals:** 3 to 4 ounces every 2-3 hours.

**Horses and Cattle:** 6 to 10 ounces every 2-3 hours.
