Stomach bleeding warning:This product contains a nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug **(NSAID),** which may cause severe stomach bleeding. The chance is higher if you:

- are age 60 or older
- have had stomach ulcers or bleeding problems
- take a blood thinning (anticoagulant) or steroid drug
- take other drugs containing prescription or nonprescription **NSAIDs** (aspirin, ibuprofen, naproxen, or others)
- have 3 or more alcoholic drinks everyday while using this product

- any other drug, or are under a doctor's care for any serious condition

Stop use and ask a doctor if

- you experience any of the following signs of stomach bleeding:
- feel faint
- vomit blood

- have bloody or black stools
- have stomach pain that does not get better
- ringing in the ears or loss of hearing occurs
