Use(s)

- treats frequent heartburn (occurs **2 or more** days a week)
- not intended for immediate relief of heartburn; this drug may take 1 to 4 days for full effect

Warnings

Allergy alert: Do not use if you are allergic to esomeprazole

Do not use

- trouble or pain swallowing food, vomiting with blood, or bloody or black stools
- heartburn with lightheadedness, sweating or dizziness.
- chest pain or shoulder pain with shortness of breath; sweating; pain spreading to arms, neck or shoulders; or lightheadness.
- frequent chest pain

These may be signs of a serious condition. See your doctor.

Ask a doctor before use if

- had heartburn over 3 months. This may be a sign of a more serious condition.
- frequent wheezing, particularly with heartburn
- unexplained weight loss.
- nausea or vomiting.
- stomach pain

Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if

- warfarin, clopidogrel or cilostazol (blood-thinning medicines)·
- prescription ant fungal or anti-yeast medicines·
- digoxin (heart medicine)·
- diazepam (anxiety medicine)·
- tacrolimus or mycophenolate mofetil (immune system medicines) ·
- prescription antiretrovirals (medicines for HIV infection)·
- methotrexate (arthritis medicine)

Stop use and ask doctor if

- your heartburn continues or worsens
- you need to take this product for more than 14 days.
- you need to take more than 1 course of treatment every 4 months.
- you get diarrhea·
- you develop a rash or joint pain

Pregnancy/Breastfeeding

If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional before use.

Keep out of reach of children

Keep out of reach of children. In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

Directions

- adults 18 years of age and older·
- this product is to be used once a day (every 24 hours), every day for 14 days.
- may take 1 to 4 days for full effect

14-Day Course of Treatment

- swallow 1 tablet with a glass of water before eating in the morning.
- take every day for 14 days
- do not take more than 1 tablet a day
