Warnings

Stomach bleeding warning: This product contains an NSAID, which may cause severe stomach bleeding. The chance is higher if you

- are age 60 or older
- have had stomach ulcers or bleeding problems
- take a blood thinning (anticoagulant) or steroid drug
- take other drugs containing prescription or nonprescription NSAIDs (aspirin, ibuprofen, naproxen, or others)
- have 3 or more alcoholic drinks every day while using this product
- take more or for a longer time than directed

Do not use

- 1. if you have ever had an allergic reaction to any other pain reliever/fever reducer
- 2. for at least 7 days after tonsillectomy or oral surgery unless directed by a doctor

Ask a doctor before use if

- 1. stomach bleeding warning applies to you
- 2. you have a history of stomach problems, such as heartburn
- 3. you have high blood pressure, heart disease, liver cirrhosis, or kidney disease
- 4. you are taking a diuretic
- 5. you have asthma

Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if you are

taking a prescription drug for

- gout
- diabetes
- arthritis

Stop use and ask a doctor if

- an allergic reaction occurs. Seek medical help right away.
- you experience any of the following signs of stomach bleeding:
- feel faint
- · vomit blood
- have bloody or black stools
- have stomach pain that does not get better
- pain gets worse or lasts more than 10 days
- fever gets worse or lasts more than 3 days
- redness or swelling is present
- new symptoms occur
- ringing in the ears or a loss of hearing occurs

These could be signs of a serious condition

If pregnant or breast-feeding,

ask a health professional before use. It is especially important not to use aspirin during the last 3 months of pregnancy unless definitely directed to do so by a doctor because it may cause problems in the unborn child or complications during delivery.
