## Warnings

# Ask a doctor before use if your child has

- liver disease
- heart disease
- high blood pressure
- thyroid disease
- diabetes
- glaucoma
- persistent or chronic cough such as occurs with asthma
- cough that occurs with too much phlegm (mucus)
- a breathing problem such as chronic bronchitis

# Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if your child is

- taking the blood thinning drug warfarin
- taking sedatives or tranquilizers

## When using this product
