• if you are now taking a prescription monoamine oxidase inhibitor (MAOI) (certain drugs for depression, psychiatric or emotional conditions, or Parkinson's disease), or for 2 weeks after stopping the MAOI drug. If you do not know if your prescription drug contains an MAOI, ask a doctor or pharmacist before taking this product.

## Ask a doctor before use if you have

- liver disease heart disease high blood pressure
- thyroid disease diabetes trouble urinating due to enlarged prostate gland
- cough that occurs with too much phlegm (mucus)
