**Active ingredient (in each tablet)**

Acetaminophen 325 mg

**Purposes**

Pain reliever/fever reducer

Aspirin-Free Pain Reliever/ Fever Reducer

**Uses**

for the temporary relief of minor aches and pains due to:

- Headache
- Muscular aches
- Backache
- Minor pain of arthritis
- The common cold
- Toothache
- Premenstrual and menstrual cramps

Temporarily reduces fever.

**Warnings**

**Liver warning:** This product contains acetaminophen. Severe liver damage may occur if

- adult takes more than 12 tablets in 24 hours, which is the maximum daily amount
- child takes more than 5 doses in 24 hours
- taken with other drugs containing acetaminophen
- adult has 3 or more alcoholic drinks every day while using this product

**Do not use**

- with any other drug containing acetaminophen (prescription or non prescription). If you are not sure whether a drug contains acetaminophen, ask a doctor or pharmacist.
- if you are allergic to acetaminophen or any of the inactive ingredients in this product

**Ask a doctor before use if the user has**

liver disease.

**Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if the user is**

taking the blood thinning drug warfarin.

**Stop use and ask a doctor if**

- Pain gets worse or lasts more than 10 days in adults and children
- Pain gets worse or lasts more than 5 days in children under 12 years
- Fever gets worse or lasts more than 3 days
- New symptoms occur
- Redness or swelling is present

These could be signs of a serious condition.

**If pregnant or breast-feeding**, ask a health professional before use.

**Keep out of reach of children.**

**Overdose warning:**

Taking more than the recommended dose (overdose) may cause liver damage. In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away. (1-800-222-1222). Quick medical attention is critical for adults as well as for children even if you do not notice any signs or symptoms.

<b>Adults and children 12 years and over</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Take 2 tablets every 4 to 6 hours while symptoms last</li><li>• Do not take more than 12 tablets in 24 hours</li></ul>
<b>Children 6 to 11 years</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Take 1 tablet every 4 to 6 hours while symptoms last</li><li>• Do not take more than 5 tablets in 24 hours</li></ul>
<b>Children under 6 years</b>	Do not use adult Regular Strength products in children under 6 years of age; this will provide more than the recommended dose (overdose) of acetaminophen and may cause liver damage.
