#### Purpose

Pain reliever/fever reducer

temporarily relieves minor aches and pains due to:

#### Warnings

**Liver warning:** This product contains acetaminophen. The maximum daily dose of this product is 10 tablets (3,250 mg) in 24 hours for adults or 5 tablets (1,625 mg) in 24 hours for children. Severe liver damage may occur if

- adult takes more than 4,000 mg of acetaminophen in 24 hours
- child takes more than 5 doses in 24 hours, which is the maximum daily amount
- taken with other drugs containing acetaminophen
- adult has 3 or more alcoholic drinks every day while using this product

**Allergy alert:** Acetaminophen may cause severe skin reactions. Symptoms may include:

- skin reddening
- blisters
- 🗖 rash

If a skin reaction occurs, stop use and seek medical help right away.

#### Do not use

■ with any other drug containing acetaminophen (prescription or nonprescription). If you are not sure whether a

drug contains acetaminophen, ask a doctor or pharmacist.

## Ask a doctor before use if the user has liver disease

Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if the user is taking the blood thinning drug warfarin

## Stop using and ask a doctor if

- pain gets worse or lasts more than 10 days in adults
- pain gets worse or lasts more than 5 days in children under 12 years
- fever gets worse or lasts more than 3 days
- new symptoms occur
- redness or swelling is present

These could be signs of a serious condition.

If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional before use.

## Keep out of reach of children.

## **Overdose Warning:**

In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away (1-800-222-1222). Quick medical attention is critical for adults as well as for children even if you do not notice any signs or symptoms.


