#### Use(s)

temporarily relieves common cold and flu symptoms:

- cough due to minor throat and bronchial irritation
- sore throat
- headache
- minor aches and pains
- fever
- runny nose and sneezing

### Warnings

Liver warning: This product contains acetaminophen. Severe liver damage may occur if you take:

- more than 4 doses in 24 hours, which is the maximum daily amount for this product
- with other drugs containing acetaminophen
- 3 or more alcoholic drinks every day while using this product

Allergy alert: Acetaminophen may cause sever skin reactions. Symptoms may include:

- skin reddening
- blisters
- rash

If a skin reaction occurs, stop use and seek medical help right away.

Sore throat warning: If sore throat is severe, persists for

more than 2 days, is accompanied or followed by fever, headache, rash, nausea, or vomiting, consult a doctor promptly.

#### Do not use

- with any other drug containing acetaminophen (prescription or nonprescription). If you are not sure whether a drug contains acetaminophen, ask a doctor or pharmacist.
- if you are now taking a prescription monoamine oxidase inhibitor (MAOI) (certain drugs for depression, psychiatric or emotional conditions, or Parkinson's disease), or for 2 weeks after stopping the MAOI drugs. If you do not know if your prescription drug contains an MAOI, ask a doctor or pharmacist before taking this product
- to make a child sleep

#### Ask a doctor before use if

- liver disease
- glaucoma
- cough that occurs with too much phlegm (mucus)
- a breathing problem or chronic cough that lasts or as occurs with smoking, asthma, chronic bronchitis, or emphysema
- trouble urinating due to an enlarged prostate gland

### Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if

- taking sedatives or tranquilizers
- taking the blood thinning drug warfarin

### When using this product

- excitability may occur, especially in children
- marked drowsiness may occur
- avoid alcoholic drink
- be careful when driving a motor vehicle or operating machinery
- alcohol, sedatives, and tranquilizers may increase drowsiness

### Stop use and ask a doctor if

- pain gets worse or lasts more than 7 days
- fever gets worse or lasts more than 3 days
- redness or swelling is present
- new symptoms occur
- cough comes back or occurs with rash or headache that lasts. These could be signs of a serious condition.

### **Pregnancy/Breastfeeding**

ask a health professional before use.

### Keep out of reach of children

In case of overdose,

get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center (1-800-222-1222) right away. Quick medical attention is critical for adults as well as for children, even if you do not notice any signs or symptoms.

#### **Directions**

- take only as directed
- do not exceed 4 doses per 24 hours
- Adults and children 12 years and over: 2 softgels with water every 6 hours
- Children 4 to under 12 years of age: ask a doctor
- Children under 4 years of age: do not use

#### Other information

Do not use if blister unit is torn or open

#### Storage

• store at room temperature 20-25 °C (68-77° F)


