Use for temporary relief of aches and pains of muscles and joints; arthritis, simple backache, bruises, tendonitis, muscle strains, muscle sprains, blisters and sores.

Warnings:
For external use only.
When using this product, do not use only products in rare cases of serious burns have been reported with products of this type. Do not bandage tightly or use with heating pad. Avoid contact with eyes and mucous membranes. Do not apply to wounds or damaged skin. Do not use at the same time as other topical analgesics.
Stop use and consult a doctor if: 1) condition worsens; 2) redness is present; 3) irritation develops; 4) symptoms persist for more than 7 days or clear up and occur again within a few days; 5) you experience signs of an allergy, such as rash, swelling, or blistering where the product was applied.
If pregnant or breastfeeding, ask a health professional before use.

Directions:
Adults and children 12 years of age and over: Carefully remove backing from patch. Apply sticky side of patch to affected area. Leave on for up to 8 hours. Repeat application, but no more than 3 times daily. Repeat patch after single use. Rubbed patch after opening. Children under 12 years of age: consult a physician.

Store at room temperature, not to exceed 80°F (27°C).
