# Active ingredient (in each tablet)

Ibuprofen USP, 200 mg (NSAID)\*
\*nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug

### Purpose

Pain reliever/fever reducer

#### Uses

temporarily relieves minor aches and pains due to:

- headache
- toothache
- backache
- menstrual cramps
- the common cold
- muscular aches
- minor pain of arthritis
- temporarily reduces fever

### Warnings

**Allergy alert:** Ibuprofen may cause a severe allergic reaction, especially in people allergic to aspirin. Symptoms may include:

- hives
- facial swelling
- asthma (wheezing)
- shock
- skin reddening
- rash
- blisters

If an allergic reaction occurs, stop use and seek medical help right away.

**Stomach bleeding warning:** This product contains a nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAID), which may cause severe stomach bleeding. The chance is higher if you

- are age 60 or older
- have had stomach ulcers or bleeding problems
- take a blood thinning (anticoagulant) or steroid drug
- take other drugs containing prescription or nonprescription NSAIDs [aspirin, ibuprofen, naproxen, or others]
- have 3 or more alcoholic drinks every day while using this product
- take more or for a longer time than directed

**Heart attack and stroke warning:** NSAIDs, except aspirin, increase the risk of heart attack, heart

failure, and stroke. These can be fatal. The risk is higher if you use more than directed or for longer than directed.

#### Do not use

- if you have ever had an allergic reaction to any other pain reliever/fever reducer
- right before or after heart surgery

#### Ask a doctor before use if

■ you have problems or serious side effects from taking pain relievers or fever reducers ■ the stomach bleeding warning applies to you ■ you have a history of stomach problems, such as heartburn ■ you have high blood pressure, heart disease, liver cirrhosis, or kidney disease ■ you have asthma ■ you are taking a diuretic

#### Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if you are

■ taking aspirin to prevent heart attack or stroke, because ibuprofen may decrease this benefit of aspirin under a doctor's care for any serious condition ■ taking any other drug

#### When using this product

take with food or milk if stomach upset occurs the risk of heart attack or stroke may increase if you use more than directed or for longer than directed

#### Stop use and ask a doctor if

you experience any of the following signs of stomach bleeding:feel faint vomit blood have bloody or black stools have stomach pain that does not get better pain gets worse or lasts more than 10 days ■ fever gets worse or lasts more than 3 days redness or swelling is present in the painful area any new symptoms appear

- you are taking a diuretic

- taking any other drug

#### When using this product

#### Stop use and ask a doctor if

- feel faint
- vomit blood
- have bloody or black stools

- chest pain
- trouble breathing
- weakness in one part or side of body
- slurred speech
- leg swelling
- pain gets worse or lasts more than 10 days
- fever gets worse or lasts more than 3 days
- redness or swelling is present in the painful area
- any new symptoms appear

#### Keep out of reach of children.

#### Directions

- do not take more than directed
- the smallest effective dose should be used
- adults and children 12 years and over: take 1 tablet every 4 to 6 hours while symptoms persist
- if pain or fever does not respond to 1 tablet, 2 tablets may be used
- do not exceed 6 tablets in 24 hours, unless directed by a doctor
- children under 12 years: ask a doctor
