Directions

- **Adults and children 2 years and over:** clean the affected area, apply a small amount not more than 3 to 4 times daily

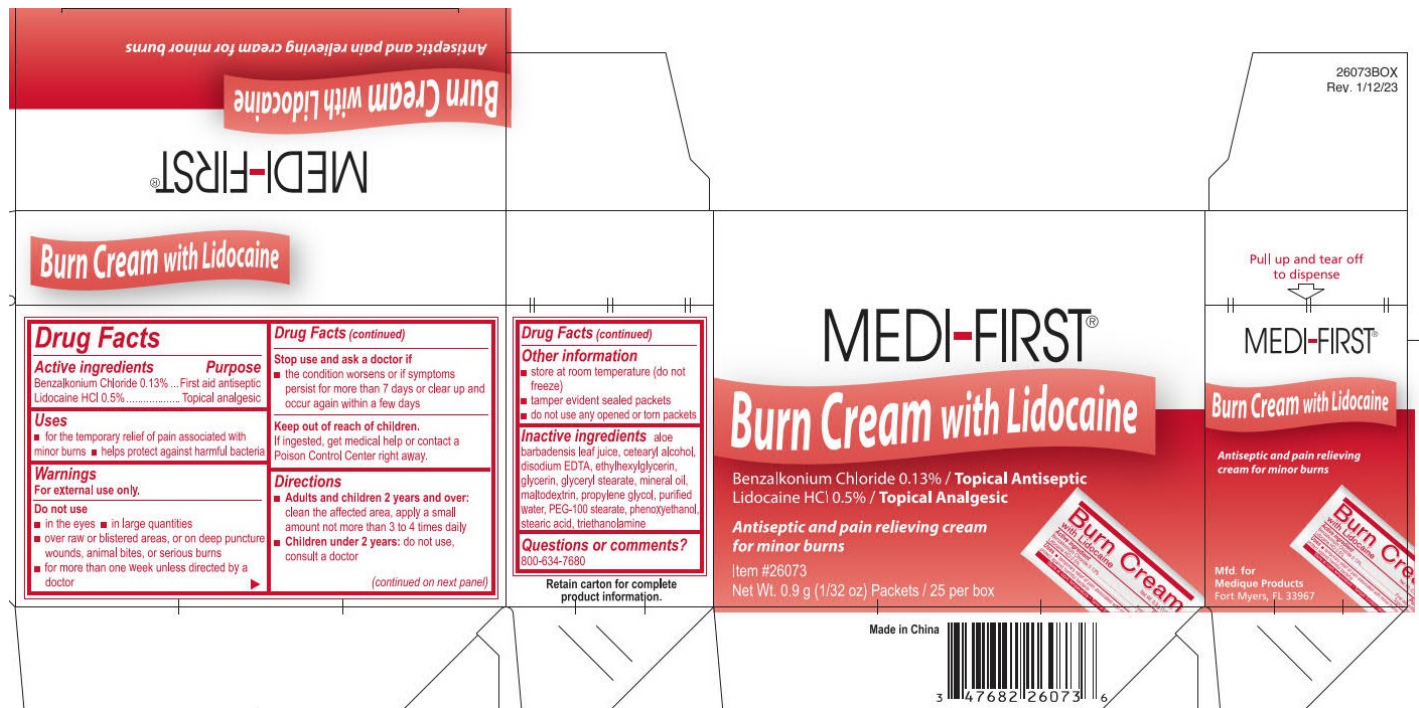
