Athlete's foot, known medically as tinea pedis, is a common skin infection of the feet caused by fungus. Signs and symptoms often include itching, scaling, and redness. In severe cases the skin may blister. Athlete's foot fungus may infect any part of the foot, but most often grows between the toes. The next most common area is the bottom of the foot. The same fungus may also affect the nails or hands. It is a member of the group of diseases known as tinea.

Tinea pedis is caused by a number of different fungi. The condition is typically acquired by coming into contact with infected skin, or fungus in the environment. Common places where the fungi can survive are around swimming pools and in locker rooms. They may also be spread from other animals. Usually diagnosis is made based on signs and symptoms.

Some methods of prevention include avoiding walking barefoot in public showers, keeping the toenails short, wearing big enough shoes, and changing socks daily. When infected, the feet should be kept dry and clean and wearing open-toed shoes can help. Treatment can be either with an antifungal medication like **FUNGINIX AF** which is applied to the skin such as tolnaftate or for persistent infections antifungal medication that are taken by mouth such as terbinafine. Use of any antifungal cream is typically recommended for a minimum of four weeks.

## **WHY USE FUNGINIX AF TO ELIMINATE ATHLETE'S FOOT?**

**FUNGINIX AF** is an excellent combination of anti-fungal agents, essential oils and fungus-fighting extracts specifically created to fight athlete's foot.
