Dear Briana Norris:

Please refer to your supplemental biologics license application (sBLA) received January 21, 2025, and your amendments, submitted under section 351(a) of the Public Health Service Act for Xultophy 100/3.6 (insulin degludec and liraglutide) injection.

This Prior Approval sBLA provides for updates to Subsection 6.2 Postmarketing Experience of the Prescribing Information (PI) to include two additional terms: 'alopecia' and 'dysesthesia' as requested in our December 11, 2024, Supplement Request letter.

Additional revisions were made to the PI and Medication Guide (MG) to align with recently approved changes in other products in the glucagon-like peptide-1 receptor agonist class, including but not limited to:

- In Section 1 Indications and Usage, the Limitation of Use (LOU) statements were updated.
- Section 5 Warnings and Precautions, Subsection 5.8 Severe Gastrointestinal Adverse Reactions was added.
- In Section 8 Use in Specific Populations, Subsection 8.8 Gastroparesis was removed.
- Additional edits made throughout the PI and MG to modernize with current labeling guidances, clarify language, and improve readability and organization of information.

APPROVAL & LABELING

We have completed our review of this application, as amended. It is approved, effective on the date of this letter, for use as recommended in the enclosed agreed-upon labeling

with minor editorial revisions listed below and reflected in the enclosed labeling.

- Added a margin mark alongside Subsection 5.8 Severe Gastrointestinal Adverse Reactions
- Revised the pharmacologic class abbreviation in the “What is Xultophy 100/3.6?” section of the MG to align with the PI.

CONTENT OF LABELING

As soon as possible, but no later than 14 days from the date of this letter, submit, via the FDA automated drug registration and listing system (eLIST), the content of labeling [21 CFR 601.14(b)] in structured product labeling (SPL) format, as described at FDA.gov,¹ that is identical to the enclosed labeling (text for the PI, Instructions for Use, and MG) and include the labeling changes proposed in any pending “Changes Being Effectuated” (CBE) supplements.

Information on submitting SPL files using eLIST may be found in the guidance for industry *SPL Standard for Content of Labeling Technical Qs and As*.²

The SPL will be accessible via publicly available labeling repositories.

Also within 14 days, amend all pending supplemental applications that include labeling changes for this BLA, including pending “Changes Being Effectuated” (CBE) supplements, for which FDA has not yet issued an action letter, with the content of labeling [21 CFR 601.12(f)] in Microsoft Word format that includes the changes approved in this supplemental application, as well as annual reportable changes. To facilitate review of your submission(s), provide a highlighted or marked-up copy that shows all changes, as well as a clean Microsoft Word version. The marked-up copy should provide appropriate annotations, including supplement number(s) and annual report date(s).

REQUIRED PEDIATRIC ASSESSMENTS

Under the Pediatric Research Equity Act (PREA) (21 U.S.C. 355c), all applications for new active ingredients (which includes new salts and new fixed combinations), new indications, new dosage forms, new dosing regimens, or new routes of administration are required to contain an assessment of the safety and effectiveness of the product for the claimed indication in pediatric patients unless this requirement is waived, deferred, or inapplicable.

Because none of these criteria apply to your supplemental application, you are exempt from this requirement.

PROMOTIONAL MATERIALS

You may request advisory comments on proposed introductory advertising and promotional labeling. For information about submitting promotional materials, see the final guidance for industry *Providing Regulatory Submissions in Electronic and Non-Electronic Format-Promotional Labeling and Advertising Materials for Human Prescription Drugs*.³

You must submit final promotional materials and Prescribing Information, accompanied by a Form FDA 2253, at the time of initial dissemination or publication [21 CFR 601.12(f)(4)]. Form FDA 2253 is available at FDA.gov.⁴ Information and Instructions for completing the form can be found at FDA.gov.⁵

All promotional materials that include representations about your drug product must be promptly revised to be consistent with the labeling changes approved in this supplement, including any new safety-related information [21 CFR 601.12(f)(4)]. The revisions in your promotional materials should include prominent disclosure of the important new safety-related information that appears in the revised labeling. Within 7 days of receipt of this letter, submit your statement of intent to comply with 21 CFR 601.12(f)(4).

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

We remind you that you must comply with reporting requirements for an approved BLA (in 21 CFR 600.80 and in 21 CFR 600.81).

Your product is a Part 3 combination product (21 CFR 3.2(e)); therefore, you must also comply with postmarketing safety reporting requirements for an approved combination product (21 CFR 4, Subpart B). Additional information on combination product postmarketing safety reporting is available at FDA.gov.
